Consumer Alert – Fraudulent Cashier’s Checks

Santa Rosa, California – March 26, 2007 – Atlantic Pacific Bank today is warning consumers that Fraudulent Cashier’s Checks are being sent to unsuspecting individuals.

The unsuspecting individuals are being asked by the fraudulent company to deposit the counterfeit Atlantic Pacific Bank Cashier’s Checks and then return a portion of the funds back to an unknown source.

These unknown persons are *attempting check fraud* and using unsuspecting consumers as their victims.

These checks are counterfeit and are not Atlantic Pacific Bank Cashier’s Checks.

The phone number on these fraudulent checks is *not a valid phone number* of Atlantic Pacific Bank.

Do not attempt to process these checks. They will be returned as counterfeit.

Atlantic Pacific Bank has contacted the appropriate law enforcement agencies to report this fraud, and locate and prosecute those who are involved in this check fraud scheme.
